
Forrest Medal Glasgow



Brian Davidson won the Forrest Medal for his pan of *Trillium pusillum ozarkanum*. Its 3 bladed white flowers sat atop their 20cm stems and looked ready to take off like wee gyrocopters. Brian's gardening must suit Milngavie because he won another Forrest here a few years back with Paeonia cambessedesii. Trillium pusillum is widespread in South-eastern USA except in Louisiana and Florida. The subspecies is found in Arkansas, Oklahoma, Kentucky and Tennessee. The Ozarks are the biggest mountain range between The Appalachians and the Rockies. This is Davy Crocket and Bill

Clinton territory; what better names for any special clones which may arise unless 'Brian Davidson' is your choice.
